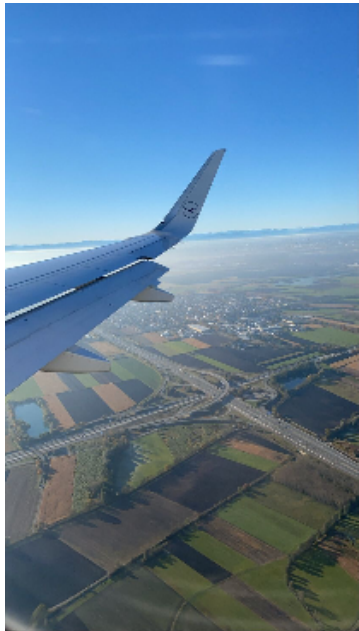
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About Poland.

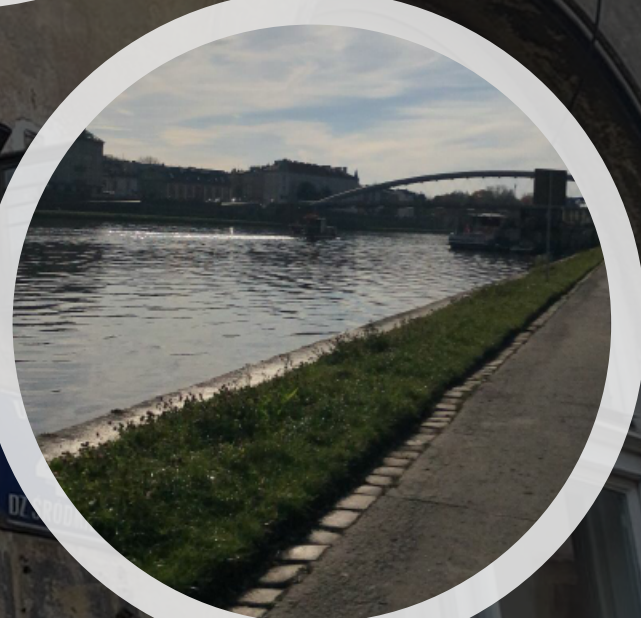






Tuesday 26 October Krakow

Nowy Square

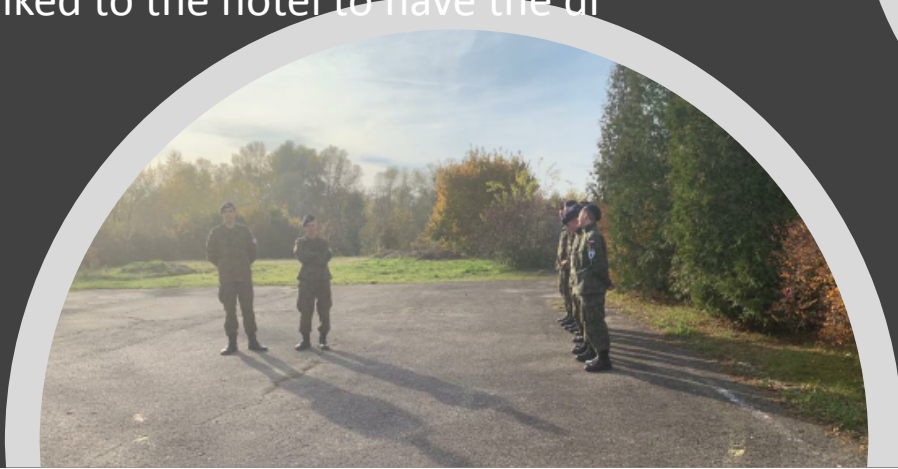
There is a small round building in the center of the square that was built in 1990 and it was used as a butchery, but nowadays there is a lot of fast food restaurant.
